21 Feb 2017, P&C meeting highlights:

Strategic plan - P&C are beginning consultation with the school community to develop a new strategic plan that will align with the current School Plan. A prioritisation and decision making meeting has been organised for Wednesday 26th April at 3.30pm – 5.30pm. Opportunities for parents to contribute ideas will be made available soon.

P&C Finances - The 2017 budget was adopted at the AGM based on 2016 figures. P&C to promote the key ways in which funds are currently raised for the school which require no outlay for parents e.g. School banking Dollarmite accounts.

Tuck shop - Many thanks to Rafia for her time, commitment and support in

organising the Tuck shop for 2015 and 2016. The Tuck shop will not be operating this term. Volunteers and expressions of interest are invited to provide a Tuck shop service at the school in 2017. Please speak to members of the P&C or email: DPSS_Volunteer_Coordinator@hotmail.com

Bus travel to swimming classes at UQ Pool - P&C seeking permissions from relevant sections of government to access UQ via the green bridge. Will update as this issue progresses.

School events - School presently updating website calendar. P&C also in process of finalising events calendar for 2017. P&C will be conducting a parent survey in coming months, calling for parents to indicate their availability to volunteer and be involved.

Communication – P&C will use the school newsletter and information bulletins to update the school community on activities and events.

Principal report:

- 1) Asbestos Safety – parents to notify school administration immediately if there is any damage to building on the school site.
- 2) Child Protection - blue cards are not required for parent volunteers or teachers but are required for everyone else - including grandparents. P&C can apply for a blue card on behalf of these volunteers.
- 3) School's strategic plan and 2017 annual implementation plan has three main priorities: reading, feedback, and consistency of curriculum development. See January's school newsletter for information on this.

Did you know that by banking through Dollarmites with the Commonwealth Bank of Australia (CBA) is a fundraiser for the school, with no extra outlay from us as parents?

Dollarmites banking is a great way to teach children of all ages financial literacy which is an important life skill for everyone. It teaches about counting, savings, interest on deposits, compound interest etc.

The CBA also pays 5% per individual deposit back to the school. To illustrate, if every child in our school deposited \$5 through school banking each week then CBA would give to the school \$3390 (the amount is worked out on 5% of the amount deposited) back to the school in a year with no actual outlay from parents. Whilst we know not everyone has an interest participating, or is in a position to do so - it is worth noting, that the funds do not have to stay in the account for the payment to be made by CBA. You can actually withdraw the funds and have the child deposit the same \$5 each week, with the same overall benefit to the school. J

Most of the fundraising our school does is as a result of the continued generosity of our families, so it is worthwhile to be aware of any opportunity for big business to contribute funds that will benefit the school

and students.
